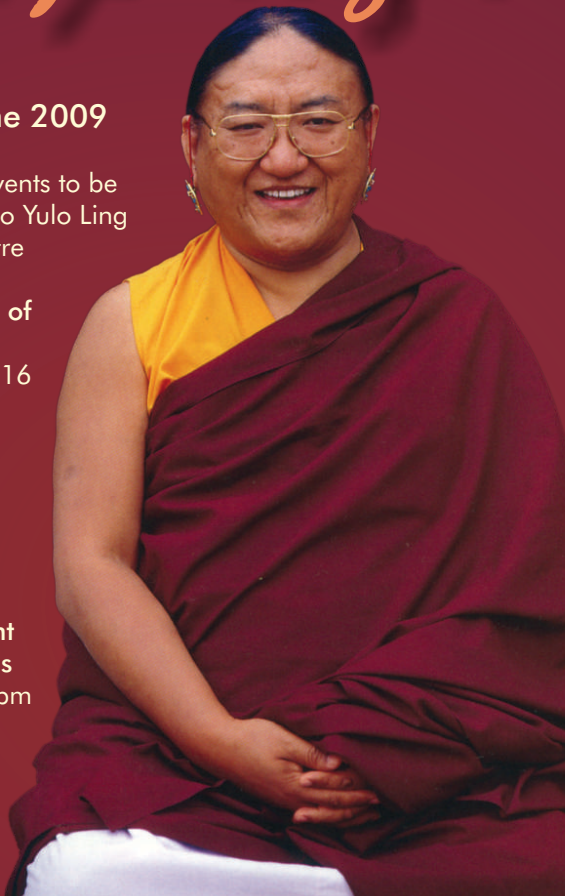

His Holiness Sakya Trizin is the 41st throne holder of the Sakya Tradition, one of the four main schools of Tibetan Buddhism. He was born in 1945, a descendant of the sacred Khon family. He is respected as an emanation of Bodhisattva Manjushri and in terms of Tibetan Buddhist protocol he is considered second only to His Holiness the Dalai Lama. His Holiness will consecrate the centre and bestow the Empowerment and teachings on the 21 Tara's at Khacho Yulo Ling Buddhist Centre.

According to Buddhist tradition, Tara was born out of the tears of compassion of the bodhisattva Avalokiteshvara. Tara's primary role is savior. She is believed to help her followers overcome dangers, fears and anxieties and especially for her ability to overcome the most difficult of situations. Tara is intensely compassionate and acts quickly to help those who call upon her for help.
